

MONTE CECILIA PARK

The APTCC event is being held in the beautiful, big park of Monte Cecilia. Its magnificent grounds contain a number of interesting specimen trees and the park also contains the extraordinary Wallace Arts Centre within the wonderfully restored Pah Homestead. The Pah Café is inside the Homestead and serves delicious delights for morning coffee through lunch and to afternoon tea.

VENUE DIRECTIONS

Monte Cecilia Park is located at 72 Hillsborough Road, Hillsborough, Auckland. (See map on back page).

From Auckland International Airport: from George Bolt Memorial Drive continue north until you merge onto South-Western Motorway/State Highway 20 (heading north), which will take you over the Mangere Bridge. Take Exit 16 and then turn right onto Hillsborough Rd. The park will be on the right approximately 500 metres.

From the Auckland CBD: from Queen St head south to Upper Queen St. Turn left onto Karangahape Rd. Turn right onto Symonds St. Turn left onto Mount Eden Rd. Turn left onto Mount Albert Rd. Turn right onto Hillsborough Rd. The

park will be on the left approximately 550 metres.

<u>Dukes Midway Lodge</u> - 4 Vagus Place, Royal Oak. Budget motel, very convenient for the venue - 1/2 km walk. Rooms from \$99

Cornwall Park Motor Inn- 317 Manukau Road, Epsom. Mid-range motel, very nice rooms, approximately 4km from the venue and handy for Mt Eden, Cornwall Park. Rooms from \$151 Best Western President Hotel - 27 Victoria Street West, City. Full service hotel in Auckland CBD, 10km from venue. Rooms from \$130

Base Auckland - Level 3, 229 Queen Street, City. Backpackers, located in CBD with nightclub downstairs. 10km from the venue. Range of options starting at bed in a dormitory for \$20, up to rooms with ensuite.
